

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu (1,400m)

After check-in, you can unwind and recover from your journey, or explore Thamel's vibrant streets before attending a quick trek briefing in the evening. Overnight stay at a hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 2: Kathmandu Tour and Preparation for Jiri to Everest Base Camp Trek

Spend the day seeing Kathmandu's famed UNESCO World Heritage Sites, including as Swayambhunath, Boudhanath Stupa, and Pashupatinath Temple. Later, finalize your trekking preparations, check your gear, and meet your trekking team for the next Himalayan expedition. Day 3: Drive from Kathmandu to Bhandar via Jiri

Day 4: Trek from Bhandar to Sete (2575m)

Begin your journey via calm woodlands, hilly villages, and farmed fields, gradually ascending to Sete. The trek offers stunning vistas of rolling green landscapes and distant Himalayan peaks along the way.

Day 5: Trek from Sete to Junbesi (2670m)

Trek through rhododendron and pine forests before crossing Lamjura Pass, one of the highest peaks in the lower Everest region. Then descend to the picturesque Sherpa village of Junbesi, noted for its traditional culture and scenic surroundings. Day 6: Trek from Junbesi to Nunthala (2220m)

Continue the journey via picturesque villages, Buddhist monasteries, and woodland pathways, taking in vistas of snowcapped mountains. Descend gradually to Nunthala, a tranquil village surrounded by beautiful hills and fields.

Day 7: Trek from Nunthala to Bupsa (2360m)

The trail descends toward the Dudh Koshi River before ascending via forests and local communities to Bupsa. Along the way, you can experience traditional mountain lives and stunning countryside views.

Day 8: Trek from Bupsa to Surke (2290m)

Trek along rocky mountain routes with vistas of hills, forests, and suspension bridges that span deep river valleys. Arrive in Surke, a peaceful town in the Everest region just below Lukla.

Day 9: Trek from Surke to Phakding (2,652m)

Join the major Everest trekking path and pass through vibrant Sherpa communities adorned with prayer flags and mani walls. Follow the Dudh Koshi River to the picturesque settlement of Phakding.

Day 10: Trek from Phakding to Namche Bazaar (3440m)

Trek through pine forests and river valleys to reach Sagarmatha National Park, which is accessible via multiple suspension bridges. After a strenuous uphill hike, arrive at Namche Bazaar, the Everest region's thriving trading hub.

Day 11: Rest Day at Namche Bazaar (3,440m) for Acclimatization

Spend the day acclimatizing to the higher altitude by seeing Namche Bazaar and adjacent overlooks; optional walks to Everest View Hotel or local museums provide amazing mountain panoramas and aid in your body's healthy adjustment.

Day 12: Trek from Namche Bazaar to Tengboche (3,870m)

Trek through rhododendron forests on picturesque routes with stunning views of Everest, Ama Dablam, and Lhotse until you reach Tengboche, home to the iconic Tengboche Monastery and the Khumbu region's spiritual heart. Tengboche is home to the famous Tengboche Monastery, the Khumbu region's spiritual center.

Day 13: Trek from Tengboche to Dingboche (4,360m)

The path descends through woodlands before crossing rivers and climbing into the open alpine meadows of Dingboche, with stunning views of Ama Dablam and the neighboring Himalayan peaks along the way. Throughout the trek, there are wonderful views of Ama Dablam and the neighboring Himalayan peaks.

Day 14: Trek from Dingboche to Lobuche

Continue walking over harsh high-altitude terrain, passing glacial rivers and steep moraines. Before arriving in Lobuche, which is surrounded by majestic Himalayan mountains, visit climber memorials.

Day 15: Trek from Lobuche to Everest Base Camp back to Gorak Shep

Trek via steep glacier slopes to reach the iconic Everest Base Camp, which sits underneath the world's highest peak. After soaking in the amazing achievement and stunning environment, return to Gorak Shep for the night.

Day 16: Hike to Kala Patthar (5643m) trek back to Pheriche (4280m)

Wake up early for a dawn climb to Kala Patthar, one of the top overlooks in the Everest area, which offers panoramic views of Mount Everest. After taking in the breathtaking environment, gently descend to Pheriche for a relaxing evening stay. After admiring the stunning view, gently descend to Pheriche for a relaxing evening stay.

Day 17: Trek from Pheriche to Tengboche

Descend through mountain valleys, traversing rivers and woods on your way back to Tengboche. Throughout the hike, enjoy the varied landscapes and breathtaking mountain vistas.

Day 18: Trek from Tengboche to Monjo

Continue descending through woods rich with rhododendron and pine trees, passing traditional Sherpa settlements, and arrive at Monjo, a tranquil community at the entrance to Sagarmatha National Park. Arrive in Monjo, a pleasant town near the entrance to Sagarmatha National Park.

Day 19: Trek from Monjo to Lukla

Follow the magnificent path down the Dudh Koshi River, over suspension bridges and passing through tiny mountain villages before arriving in Lukla, where you can celebrate your incredible Everest journey with your trekking crew. Celebrate the successful conclusion of your spectacular Everest experience with your trekking group.

Day 20: Flight from Lukla to Kathmandu, evening farewell dinner
